One of the main objective of our pilot project:
Building a network between Roma cultural and educational organisations in Hungary

- public and private organizations
- cultural and educational institutions
- voluntary structures
- public bodies (regional / local galleries, collections owned and funded by municipalities)
- Roma-led NGOs, typically supported by foreign / international grants.
