Halele Carol

The **Halele Carol** location did not experience major changes during the Covid 19 pandemic. Regarding the owner of Halele Carol, the Hesper factory, there is no information on the current status of the company, whether it suffered from Covid 19 and its intentions with the halls.

Most parts of the site are still used as storage rooms or are vacant spaces. The vacant halls can be rented for events but there is no organization that give direction for programming or marketing of the space. The part of Halele Carol that is transformed into music and nightclub „Expirat“ was still open during the pandemic. We do not have information on whether the turnover of the nightclub suffered much during this period, but at this moment, the club is still open, so it looks like they survived this difficult period.
